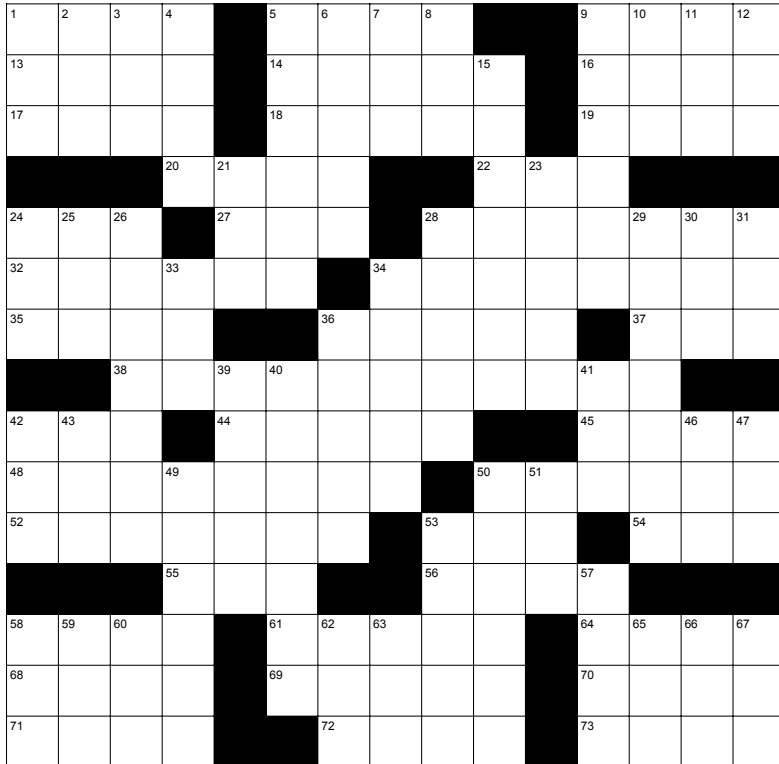


CROSSWORD
